The captive Indian seems to have been a female, and, from some cause now unknown, had incurred the vengeance of the English. Everything regarding the matter, saving the fact of the horrible execution of the prisoner, remains without a shadow of explanation. There was an *order* given for her execution, but by whom, as we have said, there is no record. The endorsement on the letter is in these words: The captive was "ordered to be torn in pieces by the dogs, and she was dealt withal"!
